Contributing Factors :

- Reproduction Poor Oral hygiene: Your pet needs dental care just like you.
- Breed: Overcrowded or misaligned teeth can contribute to the buildup of periodontal disease and are more often a problem for smaller breeds of dogs. Certain cat breeds are more likely to develop periodontal disease.
- ★ Age: Periodontal disease is more common as pets get older.

Signs of periodontal disease:

- Bad breath pain when eating
- Bleeding gum, subdued behavior,
- Pawing at the mouth change of chewing or eating habits
- Refusing to eat
- Dribbling saliva
- Tooth loss buildup of yellow-brown tartar
